

TOURNAMENT: Terms & Conditions



Nestled in a peaceful natural setting, Metchosin Golf Course is a scenic 9-hole course offering breathtaking views and a relaxed, enjoyable atmosphere for golfers of all levels.

The tournament organizer is responsible for the conduct of all participants and must ensure that all participants are aware of Metchosin Golf Course terms and conditions.

Event day details

SHOTGUN

- Shotgun starts are available for groups 64 participants or more.
- Tournaments must pay for a minimum of 64 participants, regardless of the number in attendance on the day of event.
- An additional per-person fee applies for shotgun starts.

BOOKING

- Tournaments are available 7 days a week, subject to availability.
- Tournaments may tee off at any time during the week and after 11am on weekends and holidays.
- Advance booking is strongly recommended to secure your preferred date and time.

CONFIRMATION

- Final participant numbers must be provided to the tournament director at least 7 days in advance. This number will be the minimum charged, unless a shotgun start applies.
- Any allergies or special dietary requirements must be communicated at least one week in advance. Failure to do so may limit menu availability, and Metchosin Golf Course will not be held responsible or liable as a result.

EVENT PAYMENT

- Prices are per person and include applicable taxes and gratuity.
- All bookings with 16 or more participants require a non-refundable deposit.
- Deposits will be applied to the final bill on the day of the event.
- Full payment is due on the day of the event, unless alternate arrangements have been approved by management.
- Upon payment of your deposit, a signed copy of these terms and conditions is required.

DEPOSITS

- Deposits are required for all tournaments and are non-refundable
- Tournaments with 64 participants or more require a \$750 deposit.
- Tournaments with fewer than 64 participants will require a \$400 deposit.

PARTICIPANTS & LIABILITY

- The tournament organizer is responsible for the conduct of all participants and is encouraged to review these terms prior to the event.
- The tournament coordinator (or designated organizer) assumes responsibility for all rental equipment, carts, and any damage to golf course property.
- Participants golf and walk the golf course at their own risk. Metchosin Golf Course is not responsible for personal injury or vehicle damage.
- Golfers are responsible for any damage caused by errant or negligent golf shots.
- All participants must conduct themselves responsibly. Rude or inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the property without
- Metchosin Golf Course reserves the right to discontinue service to any guest violations of course rules or provincial and federal laws. The organizer will be held responsible for any damages caused by their group.

HEALTH & LIQUOR BOARD REGULATIONS

- No outside food or beverages are permitted without prior approval from Metchosin Golf Course.
- Absolutely NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL PERMITTED. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased through Metchosin Golf Course in accordance with the Liquor Control and Licensing Act.
- Bags and Coolers are subject to inspection. Unauthorized alcohol will be confiscated immediately.
- Staff reserve the right to refuse or discontinue alcohol service at any time.

CANCELATION POLICY

- Tournaments will proceed rain or shine and will not be canceled due to unfortunate weather unless management deems the course unplayable.
- If the course is unplayable, an alternate date will be set.
- Deposits are non-refundable.

ADDITIONAL EVENT DAY DETAILS

- To guarantee cart rentals, participants must reserve carts in advance. Otherwise, carts are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Participants should arrive AT LEAST 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time for registration, rentals, and refreshments.
- Each golfer must have their own set of clubs. Club sharing is not permitted to maintain pace of play.
- Groups must maintain pace with the group ahead. Failure to do so may result in the marshal advancing groups to the next hole without completing the previous hole.
- Metchosin Golf Course can assist with event signage. All signage and promotions must be approved in advance by the tournament director and removed immediately following the event. Additional fees may apply.
